FAQs

Q: When will applications for Girls Rock Roanoke Camp be available?

A: Applications for Girls Rock Roanoke camp will be available by the middle of March 2017.

Q: Who can attend Girls Rock Roanoke Camp?

A: Girls Rock Roanoke Camp is for girls and gender non-conforming youth, ages 8-16.

Q: How much is it?

A: The tuition is \$250 – \$350 for the week plus a \$10 registration fee. Camp cost is done on a sliding scale

Q: Do you offer Financial Assistance?

A: Yes! It is part of our mission to be accessible to all girls. Scholarships are limited so fully complete the Financial Aid section of the application. Deadlines for Scholarship requests is May 15, 2017.

Q: Where is Girls Rock Roanoke camp held?

A: Community School, Roanoke's premier independent, experiential education destination is graciously hosting Girls Rock Roanoke this summer. The school features an open campus, STEM lab, music lab, art room and multiple classrooms—just perfect for our camp! Community School is located at 7815 Williamson Road, Roanoke, VA 24019

Q: When is Girls Rock Roanoke?

A: This year we will be hosting TWO camps! Camp for girls ages 8-11 will be July 10-14 and camp for girls ages 12-16 will be July 17-21.

Q: What's a typical day at camp like?

A: The week-long day camp will run from 9:00-4:00 pm.
